On the Sunday April 30, we held a dinner party because of the labor holiday is on May 1. We have a short video, children song presentation, games, and then dinner, which are simple and delicious. After several years of the epidemic, the church is now fully open, and the enthusiasm of friends and neighbour has not diminished. I am so thankful for God's gracious provision.
